Assisted Households are Eligible for Emergency Broadband Benefit

HUD Multifamily Office

HUD's Office of Multifamily Housing announced in an email newsletter on May 18 that Multifamily-assisted households are eligible to enroll in the [Emergency Broadband Benefit \(EBB\)](#), a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) subsidy program to help families and households struggling to afford internet service during the COVID-19 pandemic. Multifamily housing includes private, Section 8 Project-Based Rental Assistance housing, Section 202 Supportive Housing for the Elderly, and Section 811 Supportive Housing for Persons with Disabilities.
